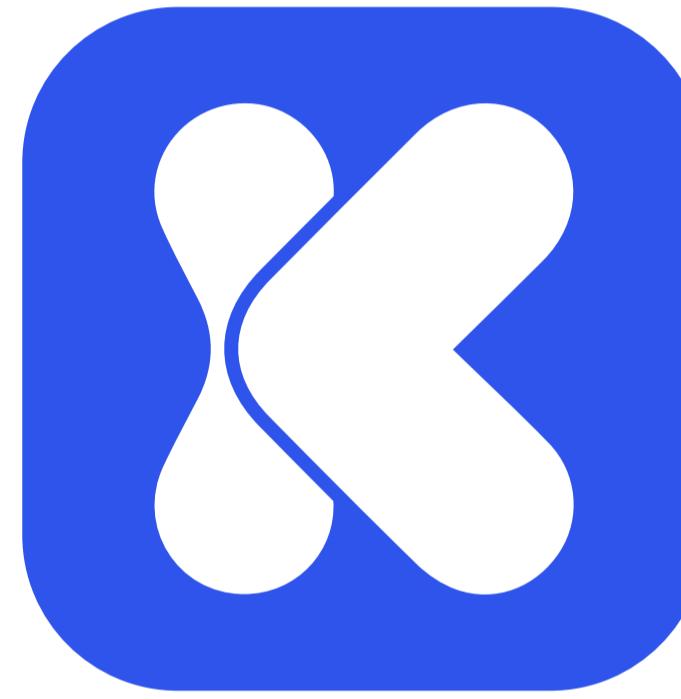

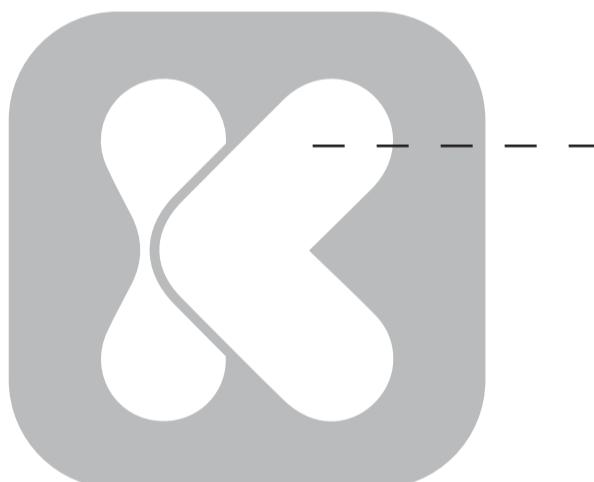
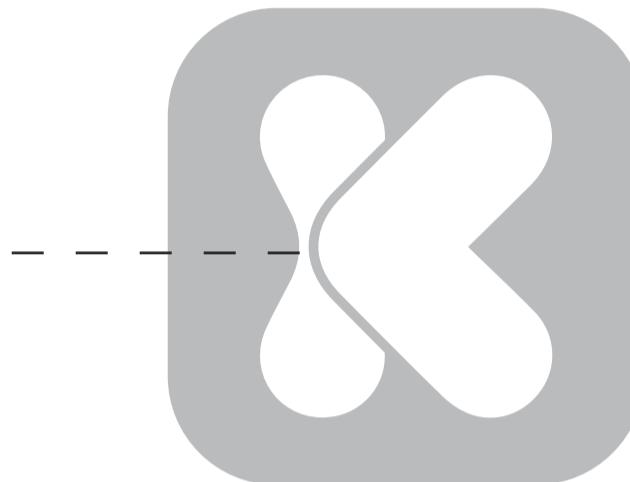

Customized Logotype – Modern Trust & Digital Precision

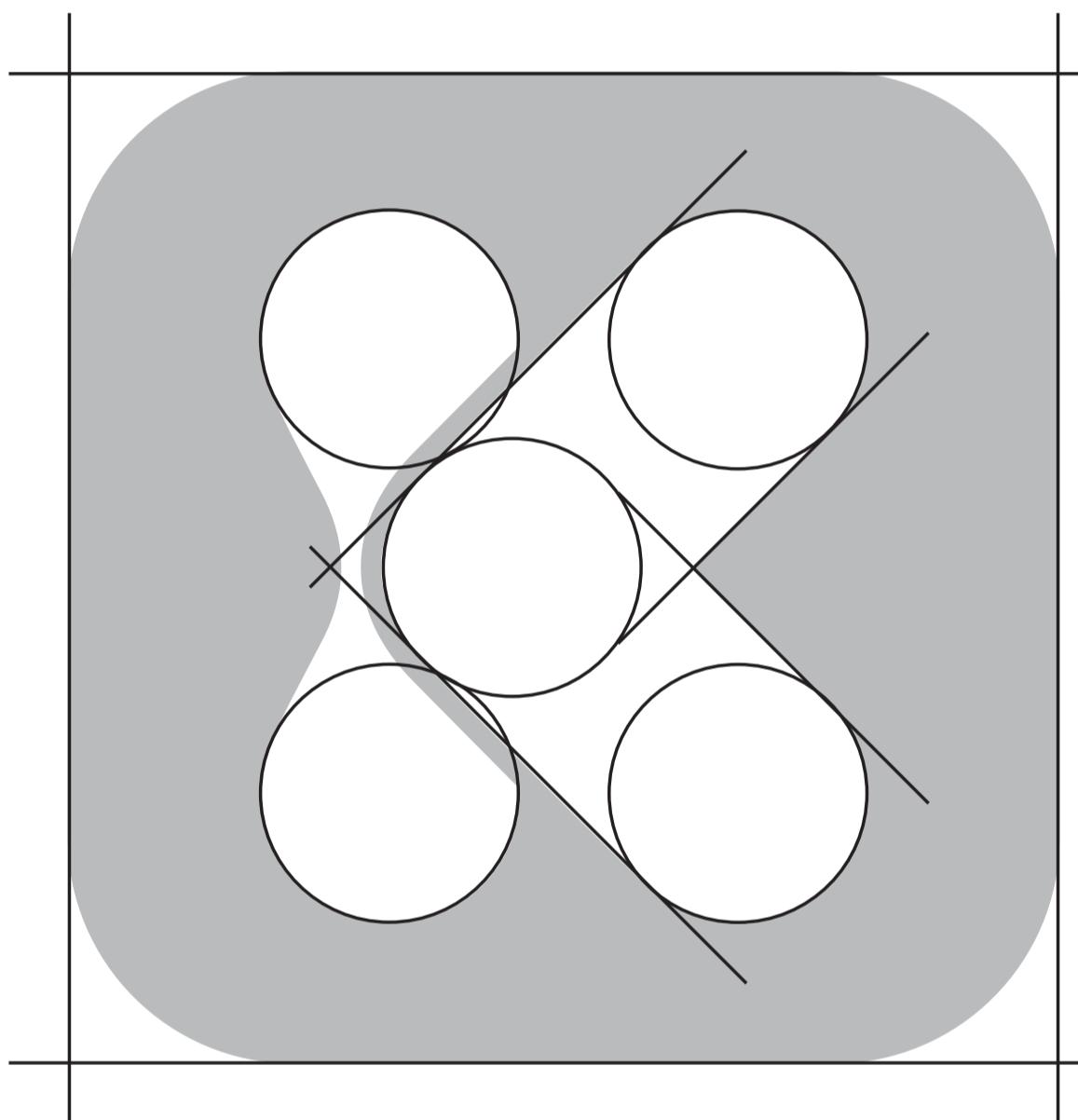

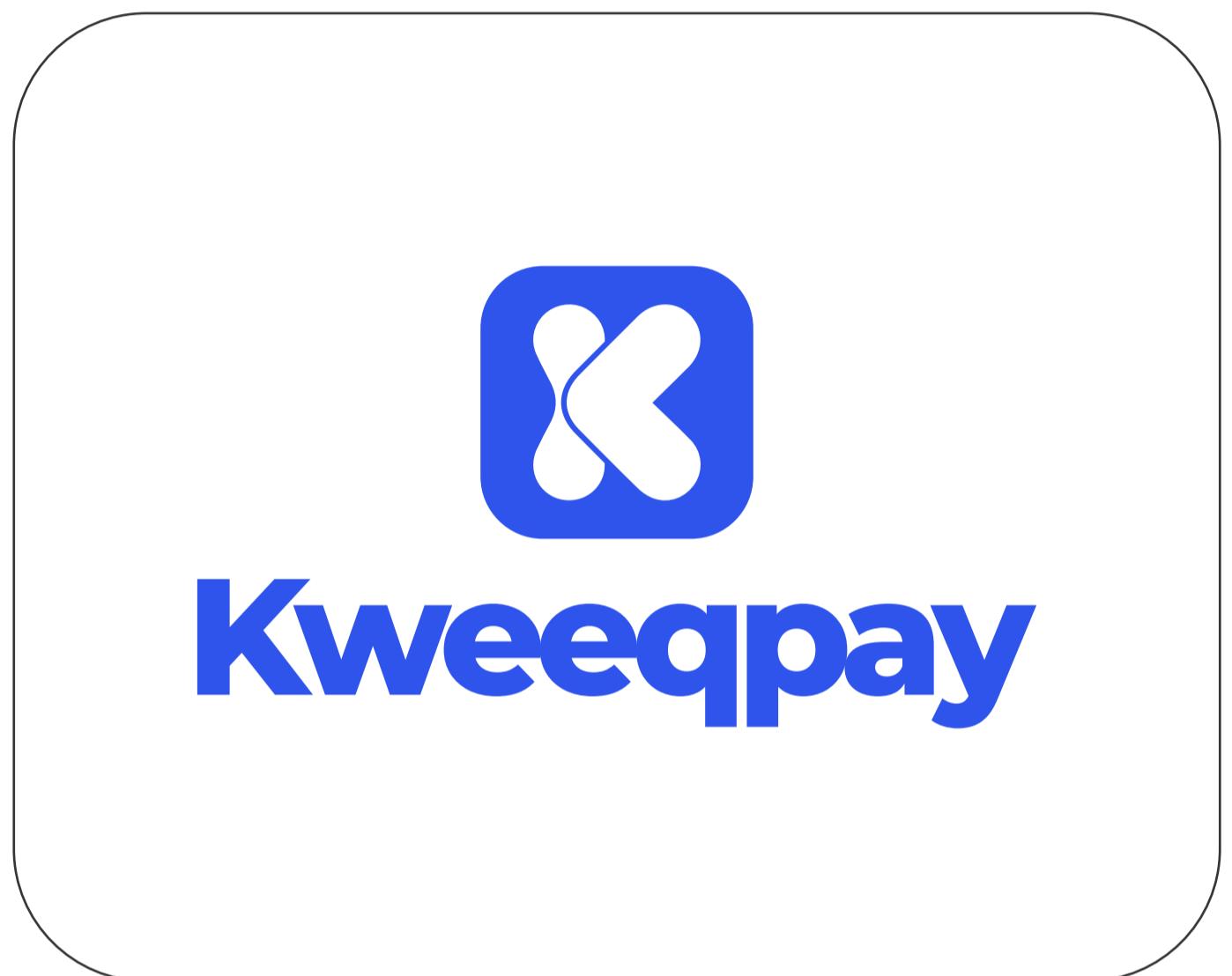
Direction & Action – Progress Through Simplicity

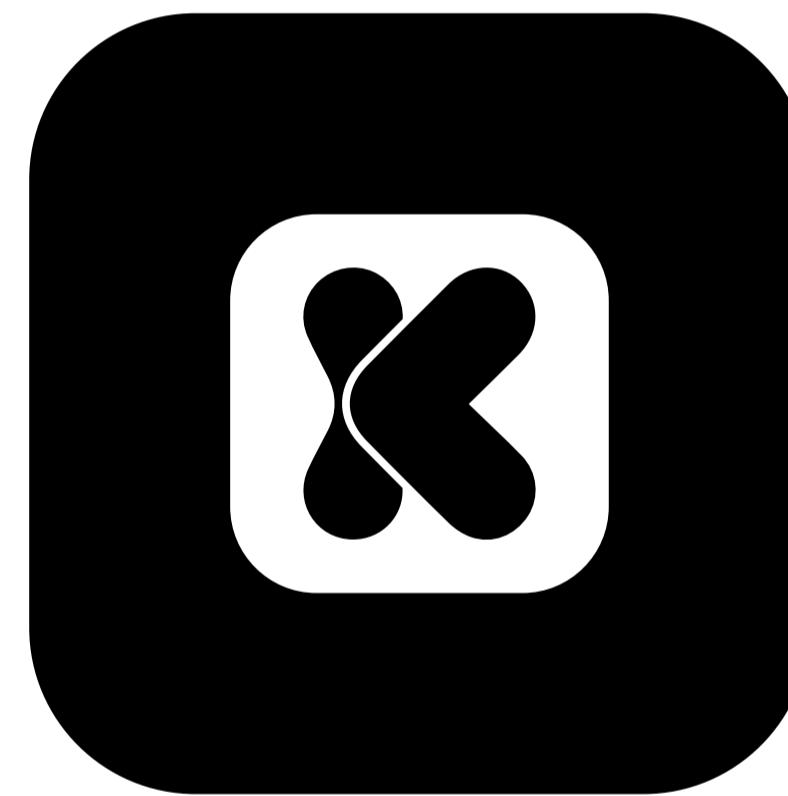
Logo Structure

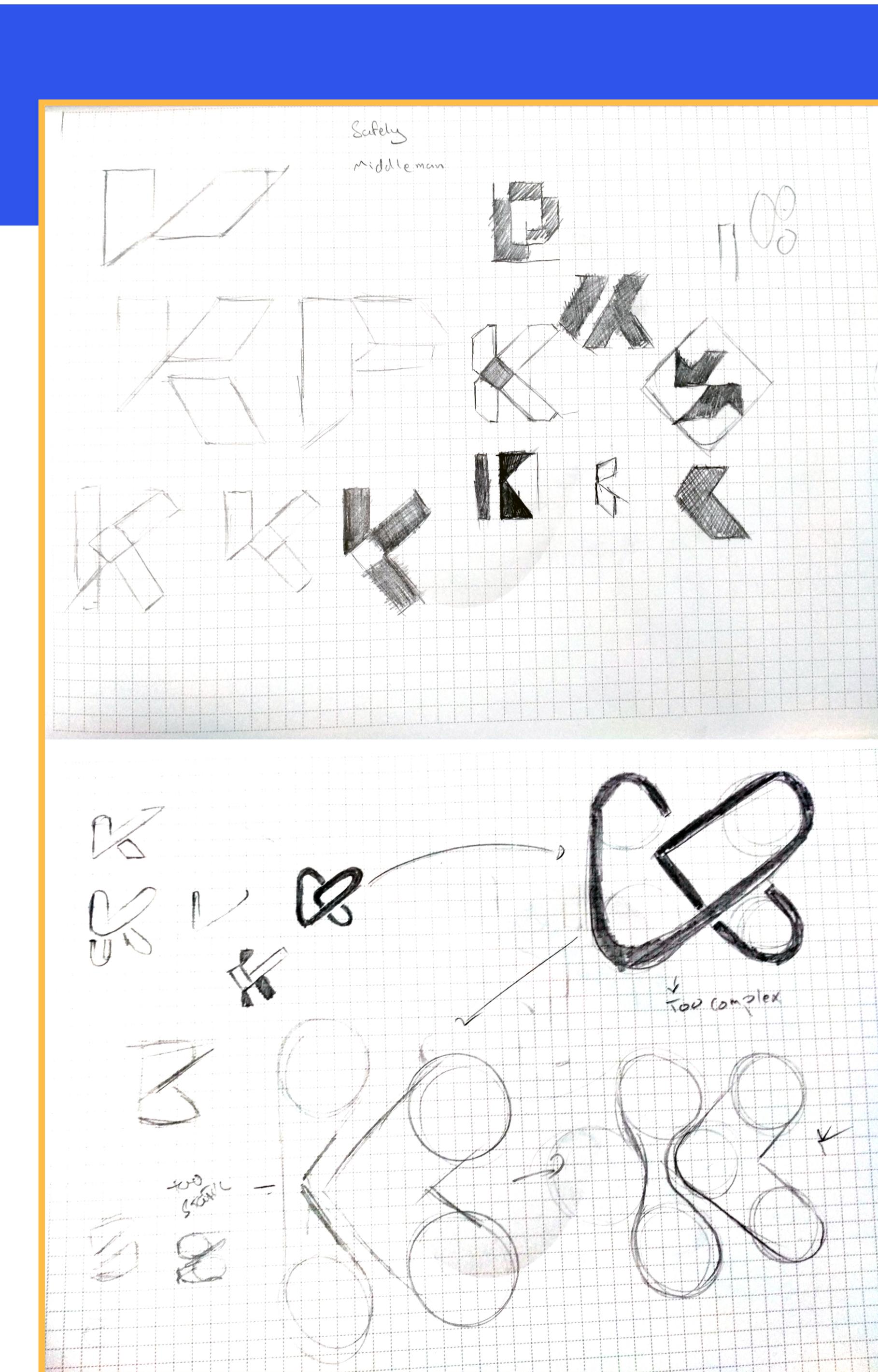




SKETCHING PROCESS

Montserrat

Montserrat is a popular, versatile geometric sans-serif font designed by Julieta Ulanovsky, inspired by the vintage urban typography (signs, posters) of Buenos Aires' historic Montserrat neighborhood, offering clarity, wide weight range (Thin to Black), and alternate styles like Subrayada (underlined) and Alternates, making it excellent for web and print branding, headlines, and body text due to its legibility.

Roboto

Roboto is a typeface family developed by Google. The first typeface was created as the system font for its Android operating system, and released in 2011.

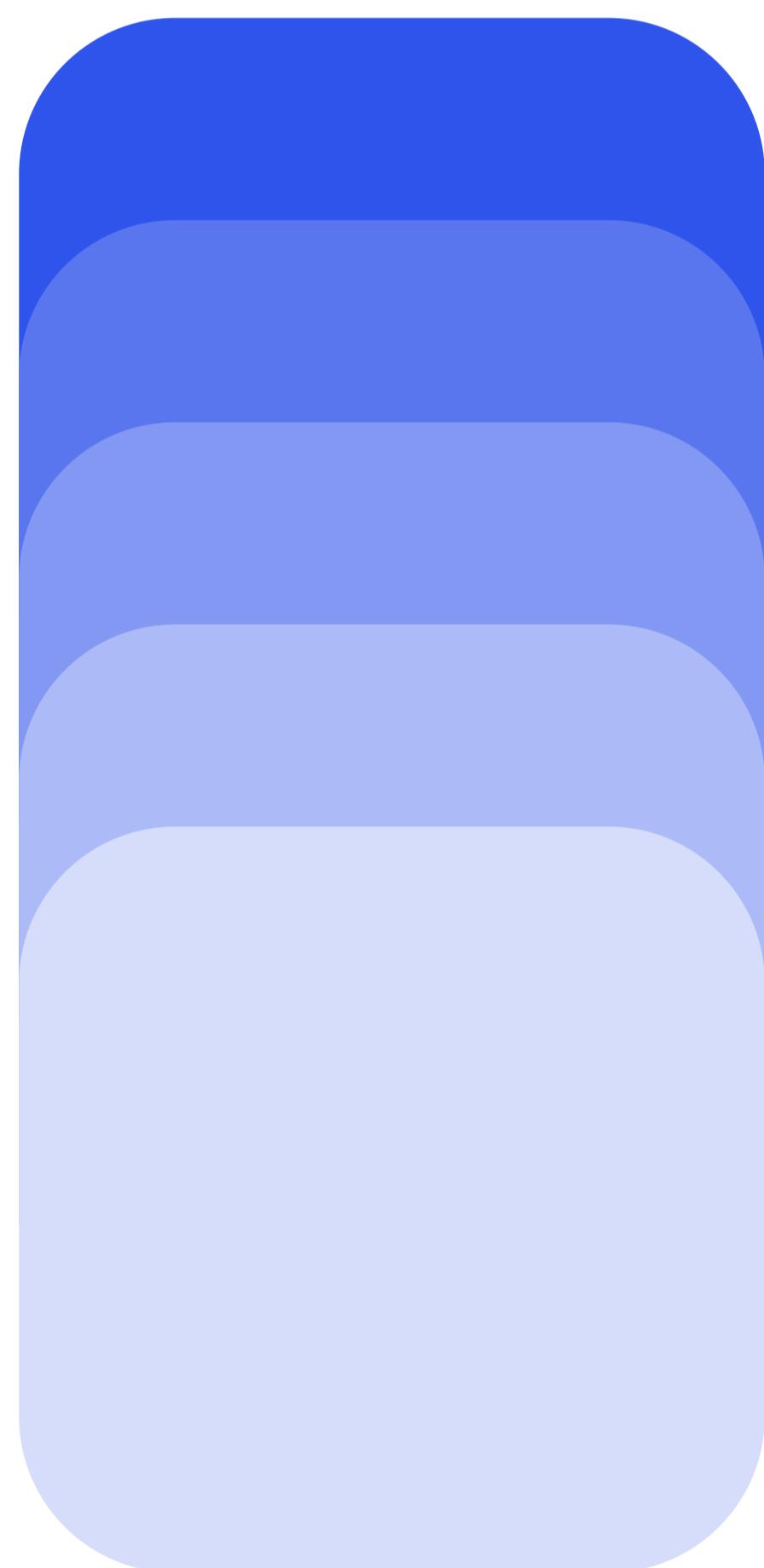
